Items from the kitchen

- Chargers
- Change of clothes
- Pyjamas

- Toothbrush and paste
- Shampoo and conditioner
- Deodorant
- Toilet roll paper
- Towels
- First aid

Items from garage

- Tools – if you need to do a little last minute DIY, like taking down a set of drawers for example, having a set of tools ready will prove to be much more time efficient. Essential for building your furniture when you've arrived at your destination too
